"ResCo is well recognized for its leadership in safety management. The introduction of the simulator to our operator training strategy will assist in maintaining this position. Being able to develop the fundamental operational and safety skills of our operators in a controlled environment will ultimately reduce safety related risks on the mine site."

ResCo says the PRO3 simulator will initially be utilized with its client Rio Tinto (Coal & Allied) Mt Thorley Warkworth site, located 15km southwest of Singleton, NSW Australia. The simulator will supplement the sites own simulator based training program which is focused on operator up-skilling and efficiency training.
